 - 3) Style: How your voice and personality come through in your writing;
 - 4) Clarity: The ability to communicate ideas effectively without ambiguity or confusion. It involves using plain language and avoiding jargon that might be unfamiliar to the reader.
 - 5) Topic: The focus and development of your central theme and how well each point reflects back on that theme.
